Questions for Session Thirteen

- 1. The disciples' observance of the massive stones and magnificent buildings led to Jesus' prophecy of the destruction of the temple, which would occur by C.E. 70. Why do you suppose Jesus addressed these comments so specifically?
- 2. As Jesus sat on the Mount of Olives with his *insiders*, what did they request of him? How did Jesus respond to their request? What other details would you like to know on this subject?
- 3. What did Jesus teach the disciples about deception? How would they know if they were being deceived? How can we be deceived today?

4. Regarding the end times or the <i>eschaton</i> , how did Jesus tell the disciples they would recognize it was upon them? Are we any closer here in the twenty-first century?
5. What were the disciples to accomplish prior to their demise? How would they recognize (v. 11) the presence of the Holy Spirit with them? What reward does Jesus promise the ones, who stand firm to the end?
6. What is the <i>abomination that causes desolation</i> , and where does it belong? Why does Jesus seem to talk with them about the end times with a sense of urgency? Is the era of the end times upon us now, or is it still far off into the future?
7. Who are <i>the elect</i> ? Is it possible for them to be deceived by false prophets? Are you on your guard? Do you think it would be possible for you to be deceived? How are we deceived every day of our lives? Give examples.
8. How will the Son of Man come, and how will he gather his elect? What has the fig tree got to do with this? Do we have a better idea of when all this will happen, now that we have read this passage of Scripture?
